Yeah, they good shoes them days.

OLD INDIAN CEMETERIES

(Where are the old cemeteries in this community?)

They use to have a family graveyard away from other cemetery. (words not clear).

(In those days, mostly family cemeteries.)

Uh-huh. Several families, they got their cemeteries over there. Down here where Granny Warren used to live is graveyard there. After they're gone you know, somebody would own that place they would do away with the cemetery and use for something else. Them Black Feather people, they had their own graves down there. There was a lot of them.

(Are there any of those Black Feather folks left?)

No, they all dead.

(They're all gone now? Just about gone now?)

Well, I think most of them's gone now. Lot of the (Words not clear) gone. Yeah, they's all gone.

NEARLY ALL OLDER INDIANS ARE GONE

Most of Indians lived here then are gone (words not clear).

(After a while they'll all be gone. If a fellow live long enough he learn something.)

Oh, yeah.

(Yeah, a long time ago folks use to live to be many years old, hundred years old.)

Like Tom Fuller. They go a long way, they go horseback or foot.

(Just across the prairie. They go a long ways.)
