He used to go way out there to have revivals but now he's retired but still they call him to preach for their churches. Last Sunday we preach at Mt. Scott.

How about you want me to tell some about the no houses and schools or anything?

(Yeah, but first could you tell me which churches you've been with?)

Saddle Mountain Baptist Church, the first one I been with--Saddle Mountain Baptist Church. Wait a minute, no, no. Methodist church, but I don't know whether I was baptized at that time, but I was baptized in the Baptist--in the Missionary--Northern Baptist Missionary Church and then when I resigned there I went to the Methodist Church.

(Do you remember what year you were baptized there at Saddle Mountain?)

I did had it, I don't know what I--

(Well, or just about how old you were?)

1914 I think it was. Same time John, at Saddle Mountain. I was baptized at Saddle Mountain when I was 12 years old. At Saddle Mountain, me and John. I got it, but I didn't get it out.

(That was before you started going to the Native American Church?)
