That's before I join any church. And I was baptize first.

Jenny: That's where has mother used to go to church. She was a Baptist and she died Baptist, the old lady. They used to go to Saddle Mountain Church. And all the children got baptized, you know, when they get up to twelve years old.

(Well, which church did you attend when you were called to be a minister?)

The Baptist church.

(At Saddle Mountain?)

Saddle Mountain.

(And then after you were ordained, which church did you start work-ing in?)

The Methodist church.

(Which one?)

Cache Creek Church. Cache Creek Church over here. They call that Albert. Horse Memorial Church—the Methodist church. That's the first appointment that I got, at the Cache Creek Indian Methodist Church after I was baptized from the Baptist Church.

HOW CECIL QUALIFIED FOR A LICENSE TO PREACH

(Could you tell me how you came to get your license, or what you had to do to get it?)

When I become a Methodist preacher I had to go to what they call the Indian Conference—the Indian Mission Conference. So I went to the Indian Mission Conference and the church had to vote whether they would allow me to—give me a license to preach. After I went there in 1934 I was licensed to preach under our Indian Mission Conference in the Methodist church. The bishop, the man that ordained, no—wait a minute, he didn't ordain me. The man that licensed me
