We call that devotional services. After that, and then after that finished and then we have a preaching hour and the preacher get up and preaches.

(During this testimony would there be children and old people all together in the same place?)

They all, one by one, get up and give their experience.

(Children too?)

Childrens, yes, sometimes.

Jenny: Sometimes the children get up and testify.

(I see.)

Jenny: Children, oh, about ten or twelve year old child would get up and testify.

(But they wouldn't have to if they didn't want to?)

Jenny: No! They didn't have to. They just do that on their own. We have a granddaughter, she's about 11 years old. I heard her. We had a prayer service, what we call a cottage prayer service and she got up and she testify and I was surprised the way she testify. Oh, I was so surprised and I was happy for her. She cried and testify.

(What did she talk about?)

Jenny: Oh, she talk about the Lord, that us older people ought to try and learn the better way to live and she talk about her older sister. She said, "I always prayed for my sisters, should become good girls and become good Christian witnesses." And I was so surprised the way she talked.

(How long ago was this?)

Jenny: Oh, it's been this last week.

(In what church?)
