Cecil: Yeah. And they do that. Now if that man, I don't know, but one man that they tell of, that he was a great, and he was an ugly, he wasn't good looking, but he's always trying to get some girls, nice, say fourteen or fifteen, thirteen years old. Just crazy up here. So, he go to a girl and say, "I want you to be my friend." This girl say, "Oh, no." Maybe slap him or do something. He get mad and he'll witch her. He'll throw something up (top of her head) or back of the neck, or right at the throat--somewhere where she could be helpless. And then when she come back, when she'll come back to him for a doctor--to doctor her. Then she'll (unintelligible phrase) that girl because she said, "I won't doctor you unless I go with you or something." That, lots of that been going on. That's in peyote, too. That's what--now some of the witches are good people. They'll doctor when you are sick. But some are just crazy, you know, just like everybody else. They doctor you to gain, to gain their love, I guess you'd call it. And that's the way a lot of the witch doctors used to pray. You know, the Indians didn't like them. They reported them to the government and they could find
