kind of treatment that might not be available in the Indian hospital, they continue to go. there, thinking that it's serving the Indians' purpose. Many times it doesn't serve his purpose 'and I think that we can be of much help and much assistance in various aspects such as this. Employment, we have Stumbling Bear from Ft. Sill, out here at the Post and we have Eddie out here in the hospital with Earl at Ft. Sill. We've got individuals here from almost every organization that goes "on in this area and I -- some of you yrobably don't krow $I I O$, so we ought to have someone in OIO that we can use in our pragram... There' 11 be parts of Boyce's program that can be used for the Indians of this area. - Community Action can bé used in various aspects: These things we need to bring together in here, see what the possibilities are and work with an objective everytime, with the idea of furthering ourselves in the community. Earl wants to say something here - . .
Earl: Ace, I dqn't'know if everybody is acquaintexd with everybody else, maybe we should have them introduce themselves --

Ace:. Okay.
