NEIGHBORS WERE WELL SCATTERED - SCHOOLS, WILD GAME, AND FISH

(That's a long ways to go and steal green apples. Well did you have close neighbors out there on your place?).

Yes

(When you were a young fellow.)

Well yes. Yes. See that land was all alloted in the '80's out there.

(Yeah)

Biggest part of it.

Then you would have fairly close neighbors out in there.)

Yeah. And the first school I went to was named Dog Town.

(Dog Town. Where was Dog Town school?)

Well it was about, let's see-- it was about three mile and a half. Kinda southwest of Alluwe.

(Uh-huh. Three and a half miles. That was old Alluwe.)

Yeah.

(Did you have prairie fires?)

Yeah.

(When you was a small boy.)

I was raised around kind of a more wooded area.

(Yeah)

We had, didn't have many in there.

(You had wood fires too, though.)

Yeah.

(Uh-huh)

(Not clear). Out there, you know. People farmed quite a bit. And they didn't burn like out here on the prairie.

(Yeah)
