Uh-huh. That's about all they had.

(Yeah, but now days all the big timbers gone.)

Yeah. Had some ash but not very much.

(Yeah, ash. Well you've seen the uh--soft timber disappear too. I guess in your time.)

Long time ago somebody'd have a burn out you know.

(Yeah)

And we'd all get together and go cut logs and haul them to the mills. Saw'em up and things like that. Sometimes called log rolling.

(Well)

That was a big help to them too.

(Sure it was. Help to the neighbors get started again after they burned out.

Well I guess that's the way they did in those days. They had to help each other.)
