It had to be done. The Dawes Commission and people were getting this Indian territory ready for statehood.

Now the original field books that go along with this map are still--Glenn Ashley, who is our county surveyor here, has that set of books. Written in <sup>1</sup>ong hand, describing--I've read--you know just come along this section here.~

Hanging on the wall here now.

(It's the map of the Cherokee Nation, 1895. When that one was made--)

Now over here west of the track.

(Uh-huh),

And Delawares east of the track you see.

(Yes sir.)
