Mr. Thomas: They were having a kind of riot up there one year you know.

All them girls turned around and walked out.

(Uh-huh)

Mr. Thomas: I forgot that guys name, Keller. Keller. He come out there and give them a long speech. "You girls go on back to the building." They (not clear) home.

(That was Harry S. Keller. Yeah. He was big boys advisor when I was there.

Oh he was mean though.)

Mr. Thomas: He wasn't cared much by students--one of them whipped him one time.

(Well someone else whipped him too. Some big Choctaw whipped him one time They expelled him.)

Mr. Thomas: He was too strict up there.

(He was, he was too strict. He made them feel inferior to everybody. And that's what they told me too. But did they have the jail there?)

Mr. Thomas: Yeah in, in Home One.

(Yeah)

Well it--it used to be up over the big office. Not the big office but the gymnasium there. Kinda, yeah it was right between Home One and Home Two.

Right between them on the corner.

(Both set back behind a little bit.)

Yeah back. They tore that down and built something else there. They had a cellar under the basement down there. (Sentence not clear). They had that--guard house up over that.
