They had acquired cars and acquired their own way of life at that time and it felt hard to convince the majority to make such a move. But they were more or less interested in their own personal affairs at that time, which were numerous and so that idea isn't going to pass. And what was one of the privileges that the Indians enjoyed at that time.
