I have a picture here that's in the little buggy and the baby is on the board--what we call--what they call cradle. It's--the baby is strapped on the board and you can see it's a beautiful picture (32). It's got beadwork overhead, down in the front, it's got bells, and it has a beautiful yarn work to go over the chest part to tie it down, but I can't recall that name. I think it was my sister's baby, but I don't know which one it was. This lady that I have is white lady. She happened to be very very dear to me. This lady I have when I went to school, she was just like a mother
