And I would encourage it for my children to attend if they were where they could. To actually take part in things. Seems like that way they mingle and they--maybe they may not learn the right customs, but it still it would be--it still would be a way of preserving some Indian customs--some Indian ways. This is my story of how I have come this far with my family. And like I said before, I promised myself that I would marry an Indian because it would was always in my heart to be what I was--to be an Indian and which I was never able to do in my childhood. And I am glad that my children could be around Indians and obtain white--Indian teaching that they have had. It is good. All of it is good. The religion and all. The older teachings are--they mean more than any teachings that I can see now. . . . Associates. . . So this was. . .
