cèremonies, and game time. Its location would have been about six miles east of Kenwood, in Delaware County, on upper Saline Creek. At one time when John was a young man, he worked with trashing machine crews during the summers on Long Prairie, Little Kansas area, and Lowrey Prairie. The present generations have missed seeing the colorful steam engine and belt-driven grain separators during their day: Mr. Diry looks back on those-days with fond reflections.
