Say--(speaks in Kiowa to Mrs. McDaniels)

(Mrs. McDaniels: That's all you got.)

I always watch it close.

(Mrs. McDaniels: This one came off from that--)

This is buffalo tail. When you get wounded, the medicine, you eat that.

(Speaks in Kiowa. Searches for something else.) See, these feathers goes with it.

(Mrs. McDaniels: Here's some more.)

(Eugenia talks Kiowa) Right there, there's some of it--buffalo tails.

(Speaks Kiowa to Mrs. McDaniels)

(Mrs. McDaniels: Um-hum. Here's the one, too.)
