Yes. I tell you. They was the first Indian tribe that was in this country, when Columbus come here, when he come to United States. Delaware Indians was first Indian he met.

(Hum-m-m)

That's in the history.

(Yeah. Well they came a long ways then.)

Yeah.

(No there's not many Delawares left. I haven't found very many of them.)
You see quite a few at Alluwe down there.

(Yeah)

Old Johnny Cake. He's been there quite a while.
