Well, it probably is Dick, that's who I'm trying to think of.

(Yeah.)

Dick used to live around here. You take that writer, I saw him but I didn't know him, but I knew Dick in person.

(Well.)

And Charles Sequiche and Esther Brown, January 11, 1897. Well that is a wonderful record. All of these are Indian folks, too.

(Yeah. Jack Downing and Susie Boudinot. Well, and John Downing and Jane Woodall.)

That's these Woodalls around here, you know. You probably know some.

(Yeah, I know some of 'em. And then an Indian by the name of just Redbird. And Indian by the name of Chalote. David Mixwater and an Indian lady known only as Betsy. Well, that is a wonderful record. Mr. Casto, where did they Franklin's live, particularly then? Was he of this community?)

Oh yes, he was just right north of Timpson prairie, west of Timpson chapel,
