Yes, Mission they called it.

ONLY CREEK AND NEGRO STUDENTS - NO CHEROKEES OR CHOCTAWS

(And let's see, were there any Cherokees that went there? Or was it the--?)

Indians. Creek Indians.

(Creeks and the colored students.)

Colored girls and boys.

(Well that made it real nice there? Were there any Choctaws there?)

If there was we didn't know it.

INDIAN CEMETERIES

(Yeah, just the Creeks and the Colored people. All right now did the Mission have a cemetery?)

No. It was an Indian cemetery close to but they didn't bury any students there.
