Of a night--women use it.

(Yeah.)

They just about all gone now.

(Well where did all the Shawnees go to?)

Well all of the older ones died out. And the younger ones they just scattered out.

(Weah.

There ain't much work around here to do.

(No there's hardly anything in the Shawnee Hills.)

And they go down around Tulsa or somewhere like that.

(Yeah, Vinita.)

Yeah. That's where you find them at.

(Uh-huh. Well who were the big families back long time ago, that were here in these hills?)

Well I don't know. There were several big families.

(Yeah. The Secondines were big family.)
