

(Next song, Number 62 played. John Pedro sings.)

Yeah, that's an Arapaho song. He's talking there--in Arapaho.

He said, "The peyote, the herb that I'm taking, have a pity on me as I sit all night long." "As I sacrifice sitting up all night, the herb that's I'm taking, the Lord has created this medicine that have a pity on me." That's what he's singing.

(Next song, Number 63, played. John Pedro sings.)

That's an Arapaho song there. That has words in it too, but he's not putting them in. "It's the beginning of morning. ~~Here I sit~~ all night."

(This was the end of the tape being played, T-522, for identification.

Now Jim plays a portion of one of his own tapes to show how he, himself sings peyote songs. The first song played is one played earlier and sung by Bobby Pedro, possibly Number 8 on T-522. Then several other songs are played. Jim identifies each one by tribe. They are Caddo and Arapaho.
