INDIAN DOCTORS WILL TAKE PAY BUT REFUSE TO STIPULATE A CHARGE

(Vonnie, how much does an Indian doctor charge? They charge different prices, don't they, depending on...?)

You mean when you have your medicine made? Faye, a medicine that really does know something, we won't price what he things - he'll expect you to pay him, but he won't tell you how much. You can pay him in money, you can pay him in groceries or you know, you can buy a shirt and take it and say, "Well, I got this." But they will not charge a certain price. A person that does charge a certain price don't know nothin'. I found that out a long time ago. Really, that's true. A person that doesn't know nothin' will charge so much - That's what I was talkin' about a little while ago - There's some doctors that do know medicine and some that says they do but don't really. And those are the ones that will say, "Alright, that's ten dollars," and you hand them a ten dollar bill and it doesn't work. And those that does know something will not price it. They'll just say, "Whatever you think." You ask'em. I know I've done it myself. I've said, "how much do you want me to give you?" "Well, just whatever you want to give me." So it's really up to the individual. You give them what - if you want to give them \$3, there's three dollars there. If you want to give them more, it's up to you. That's the way it is.

(So usually the - the ones that - the authentic ones, the ones that really knows what's happening, they don't have a set price?)

That's right. They leave it up to you.
