Arter investigating the matter with reference to the building of the hay barn at Kintah, I have concluded that it would be a dangerous undertaking, as well as a constly experiment. I have had several talks with men who have had experience along that line and they tell me that the danger of fire is very great, and that it is a risk that insurance companies do not, and often will not handle; their reasons being that it furnishes refuge for tramps, and its proximity to the railroad renders it liable to be ignited from sparks from passing engines, and in fact they find objections too numerous to mention when you attempt to insure this class of proper-I have concluded to say to you that all that portion of my barn here, except that which contains about 50 tons of hay can be used by you, and I will agree to fix a good road between here and Kintah so that the transportation of this hay will be greatly facilitated.
