The patron should be advised that there are a number of materials regarding this series ("Separate Statehood Movement"), which, due to their large size, are located in the Outsize Box of this collection.

The materials therein consist of the results of the special election held throughout the Choctaw Nation on December 19, 1903 to determine whether or not the Nation supported the call for an International Constitutional Convention to create a state out of the Indian Territory.

Most of the results are in the form of large tally sheets from the various precincts and towns from a number of counties of the Nation, on which voters signed their name and recorded their vote.
