Present.

Gentlemen:

Referring to your communication of the 22nd of March relative to the sum of seven hundred twenty eight and $\frac{77}{100}$ dollars (\$728 $\frac{77}{100}$) Creek funds unaccounted for by W. N. Garrett's Creek Indian agent, & have to advise you, that by letter of the 2nd Auditor, dated the 1st inst, he informs me that the above sum has never been paid to the Creeks but was used by the United States in the settlement of the accounts of agent Garrett.

In accordance with the suggestions of the 2nd Auditor, the item on the 12th inst. was reported to the Hon. Secretary of the Interior with the recommendation that the matter be laid before Congress in order that the amount be incorporated in the ~~Currency~~ Civil Bill.
