TEMPORARY WITHDRAWAL  
OF CREEK TRIBAL LANDS FROM ALLOTMENT.

It is hereby ordered that all unallotted lands or public domain of the Creek Nation or Tribe of Indians in Oklahoma, including any land the title to which has been or may hereafter be for the Creek Nation in any pending or other suit or otherwise, be, and the same is hereby, temporarily withheld from allotment to members of said Nation or Tribe, pending the enactment of legislation by Congress, during which time no certificate or patent shall be issued conveying to any member of the Creek Tribe of Indians any of said lands in allotment.
