

J O I N T   R E S O L U T I O N .

Withholding from allotment the unallotted lands or public domain of the Creek Nation or tribe of Indians, and providing for the sale thereof, and for other purposes.

RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:

That the unallotted land or public domain of the Creek Nation or tribe of Indians, including any land the title to which has been or may be recovered for the Creek Nation in any pending or other suit or otherwise, be, and the same is hereby, withheld from allotment to members of said nation or tribe, and that the Secretary of the Interior be, and he is hereby, authorized, in his discretion, to cause such land to be sold or leased for the benefit of the Creek Nation or tribe of Indians under such rules and regulations as he may prescribe. the proceeds of such sale or lease to be paid into the Treasury of the United States to the credit of said Creek Nation.
