BE IT ENACTED BY THE NATIONAL COUNCIL OF THE MUSKOGEE NATION:

That there be and is hereby appropriated out of the general fund, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of Seven Thousand Three Hundred Eighty Eight Dollars and Ninety-Four Cents (\$7,388.94), in favor of S. W. Brown, former Treasurer of the Muskogee Nation, to re-imburse him for amount found to be due him by the Committee on Finance on account of Clerical error made in his final settlement with the Nation.

Such payment to be made in accordance with such rules and regulations as may be prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior for the disbursement of Creek funds.
