W. Brown, former Treasurer of the Muskogee Nation, to re-imburse him for amount foundto be due him by the Committee on Finance on account of Clerical error made in his final settlement with the Nation.

Such payment to be made in accordance with such rules and regulations as may be prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior for the disbursement of Creek funds.
