Your letter of the 5th has been received - The claim you speak of was for a Reservation of Land made I think by your father during his life-time Ned Hendricks mentioned it to me before the war and stated if I remember correctly that these lands were worth probably about \$9,000.⁰⁰ and that you and your sister Phebe were the only heirs

I have never examined into the claim and can not give you any positive information in relation to it

The papers Fanny sent me against Col Chilly McIntosh I have not been able to collect anything on as warrants have come for the persons named in them - and the old gentleman seems so poor he cannot give up what little he gets on other claims -
