Dear Sir I have sent a letter today ordering the Judge to send his S. H. men to go and stop the Building of the fence I have written to him 4 or 5 times asking him to see that the Pasture be not build or telling him that under the law that Pasture could not be built. all the information I have had from time to time by Petition and letters from the People I could only learn from them that it is to be built, Your is the only letter that showed me that

They had already commenced building and I have now written him asking him to immediately send a Light horse to tell them to stop the work and if they dont stop & put on wire I would be compelled to order it cut and more than that I would ask the Tax collector to Tax any stock of Cattle brought on those lands, to collect \$3<sup>00</sup> per head & turn them out as the Judge may not get my letter soon and if you see any of them men working on the pasture or interested in it show them this letter so they can stop without going to more expenses

Those folks out there need not fear I am going to carry out the law if I am never nominated. That is my business
