Gentlemen:

I have the honor to submit before your honorable body my suggestion as to how the election returns should be counted, that I respectfully ask that a committee of one member of the House of Kings that voted for the agreement and one that voted against said agreement, and in like manner and same number out of the House of Warriors to be elected by their respective Houses, for the purpose of whose duty will be to count the votes cast in each town, and two responsible citizens each on aside that voted for and against to be appointed by the Principal Chief, to accompany and assist said committee for the purpose of satisfaction to the citizens of the Creek Nation, and further ask that you pass a Resolution to that effect as above suggested and authorizing Chief to make such appointment.
