R. 10896) making appropriations to supply deficiencies in the appropriations for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, eighteen hundred and eighty-eight, and for prior years, and for other purposes, viz: Insert the following:

1 To pay the expenses of transportation of two hundred and
2 seventy-four Creek Indians at thirty dollars each, and sub-
3 sistence for twelve months at twenty-five dollars each for
4 one hundred and sixty Creek Indians, said Indians being
5 named and described in a list appended to the letter of
6 A. B. Upshaw, Acting Commissioner of Indian Affairs, dated
7 nineteenth of June, eighteen hundred and eighty-eight,
8 set forth in Executive Document Number One hundred
9 and ninety-eight, Fiftieth Congress, first session, and being
10 entitled to the sums per capita due them under the treaty of
11 , eighteen hundred and twenty-six, and the treaty of
12 , eighteen hundred and thirty-two, with the Creek In-

13 dians, the sum of twelve thousand two hundred and
14 twenty dollars, to be paid to the person authorized to
15 receive and pay out the same to the persons entitled thereto
16 by the legislature of the Creek tribe of Indians; and
17 said sum shall be distributed only to the Indians named
18 in said list, or their legal representatives, and the payment
19 under this act shall be a full and final discharge of the United
20 States from all further liability to any Indian of said tribe on
21 account of any claim for transportation or subsistence under
22 said treaties or under any act of Congress relating to said
23 treaties.
