

would dance this way for some time, when the women would join them, dancing single file around a circle inside the circle of the men dancers. The songs would change to general songs, ones that all could and did sing. This would continue until all were tired, then they would call a halt and all would eat again. Next the women danced alone, singing songs peculiar to them, after which they would fall out, and the men would again form lines, and dance and sing, until dawn or exhausted. At every change, they would all gather around the great iron pots and eat.

The buffalo dance always followed this green corn dance, after a lapse of two days; so all stayed two days, or until the Buffalo Dance.
