MISS HOLLAND'S STORY:

My parents came to Oklahoma in 1898, from Kansas, in wagons, but did not stay. They returned to Oklahoma September 5, 1905 to make their permanent home.

"There is an old indian cemetery, still used for a community burial ground in Section 34, 7-6, And an old family burrial [sic.] ground just northwest of Chickasha where highway 81 acrosses [sic.] the washita river. I own the land and old ford that was a part of what was known as the silver city trail across bitter creek from this settlement and one at Rush Springs to the then pro[s]perous silver city trading point."
