OLD INDIAN CHURCH SITE

The first Euchee church started south of Bixby, Oklahoma, On Smake creek was Buck Chapel. John Buck, old time Indian, started this church in 1900. He was an old Indian fiddler, aged about 85 years, when he started this church, he talked the Euchee language, and the Creek language.

A storm blowed his house over and that scared him so bad that he began to preach and started this church. He had lots of members belonging to this church. This church is out of existence now, and all of the members are dead, except John Cooper and Sam Cooper.
