George Sparks of Cookson came to Creek Nation, 1889. His father rented a place from John B. Jones out near the Indian Agency. He was well acquainted with the Jones family. Appletree Smith lived near the Sparks family. When Ex-vice-president Curtis was U. S. Senator, he came to see Appletree Smith and Appletree helped him work out the Curtis Bill. He stayed several days with Appletree Smith and I was there when they were working on the Curtis Bill. We lived on the John B. Jones farm several years.
