THE OLD ROAD THAT WAS USED IN AN EARLY DAY IN
TRAVELING NORTH AND SOUTH THROUGH WHAT IS NOW
ADAIR COUNTY, OKLAHOMA

This road entered Adair County at the south side, about where John Mc-Kitchen now lives, which is in the southwest side of the county, thence in a northeasterly direction to the old Rabbit Bunch place, thence about north to where the town of Bunch is now. From Bunch, it followed Sallisaw, winding from one side to the other for about seven miles. From there, it took about a southeast direction to the Flint Court House and from there, it ran almost north to where Stilwell, Oklahoma now stands. From there it went to where Baron is now. It ran almost north and from Baron to the north side of the county it passed through what is now Westville and Watts and out of the county just north of Watts.

The above described road was used for the north and south travel through what is now Adair County, Oklahoma.
