OLD INDIAN MISSIONS

Mr. Hamilton remembered the old Mission at Eufaula Boarding School which is located at Eufaula, Oklahoma, on the southwest edge of town. It is still in operation as a boarding school for Indian girls. It still retains its name as Eufaula Boarding School. Then he recalled the others which I have already made reports on, such as, Wealaka Boarding School for Indians, Nuyaka Boarding School, Old Indian Mission or Orphans' Home in Okmulgee, Oklahoma. He knew of an old Indian school at Wewoka, Oklahoma, which he had forgotten the name of. I found out later it was called Mv'hahvcuko which means School House in the Creek language. It was called Mohaku by the white people.
