A Federal Court had been established in what is known as the Sandyland District at Pauls Valley.

Another such Court was at Ardmore.

After the posse had fought it out with the Henry Masoner gang between Allen and Heldenville, they were returning with two or three of its members when they passed by our ranch.

The rest of the members of the gang followed the posse back and if they had caught up with them there would have been another fight. The gang wished to release the members that had been captured.

The two or three outlaws arrested by this posse were taken to Pauls Valley for trial.
