INDIAN HUNTING GROUND
(by Willie Tiger)

Willie Tiger 56 years old is of Long Tiger band of Euche
He was born in this location on Blue Cat Creek and lives 6 miles of
Kelleyville, Okla. He says that the Euche Indian use to go hunting
over at Shamrock Okla. That was the hunting ground for the Indians they
would hunt wild games such as deers wild turkey and squirrels. He says
they would camp for a week to hunt game and also there were good spring
of waters there. This location was on Willie Sam Brown place over close
to Shamrock 2 miles east of that city where it is now, there was no
Shamrock at that time. He says at the present time the Indian would
hunt for games there and they would kill lots of deers and turkeys and
squirrels too. He said the women would cut up the deer meat and dry
it out to bring it home, for winter use. The Turkeys that they had
killed they would eat them and the feathers of the turkey they would
use them for such as making feathered bed mattresses for home use.
