Harry J. Hart born in Ripley county, Indiana, Jan. 4, 1868.

Robert E. Hart, father, born Ripley country, Indiana, 1832. Martha  
Ella B. James born in Ripley country, Indiana in 1839. Came to Arkansas  
in 1879 and to Oklahoma in 1890 in a two-horse wagon to M. J. Holland  
from west of Woodall School Dist. have lived in this district every since.  
Father buried in Holland cemetery. I married Jonanna Hubbard. She is a  
descendant of Chief George Lowry. I farmed ever since I have been to  
Oklahoma. Went to school in Arkansas. I reared my family at that place.  
It was very thinly settled. The Holland place, Hendrix place and Martin  
place were about all the settlements around here.

Mr. Hart has a nice country home and farms. When plowing one time  
he plowed up two large limestone rocks, shaped just like an anvil. He  
has them on each side of his walk. Mr. Hart has been responsible for the  
building up of his community.
