OLD TURKEY TRACK TRAIL.

Old Turkey Track Trail started at Red Fork then went two miles west to Old Yajjie Ranch, then on south west, crossed north of Bowden and on north west to Willie Anderson Ranch. The Trail led on north-west to head of Rock Creek. Followed the Creek south to Old Saad Springs then on to Skull Creek to James Wolfe place, from there to Turkey Track Ranch owned by Olef Miller, goes on west of Cushing and crossed mouth of Euchee Creek on north Canadian River. From there on to Berry near Stillwater and through Ctoe Reservation then passed Old Indian village or Agency now known as Red Rock. Then went two miles north of Tonkawa and went on north west passed by Newark and straight north to Great Bend, Kansas, a shipping point.

OLD SPEACHEE OR MAYAKA STAGE ROUTE

The Stage Route started at Red Fork, went south on the west side of Twin Mounds Hill, passed Mounds to the east then to Salt Creek Stomp Grounds, and there on to Speechee and to Mayaka, then passed the Old Creek Post Office, went on South east, across north Canadian to Eufaula.
