The Ramona Cemetery is located just about one-half mile south of the town of Ramona. The ground was originally allotted to Tom Leaf. It is now in the possession of the city of Ramona. It was deeded to the city of Ramona by brothers, Frank and Joe Little. The past year there has been an addition to the cemetery on the north side. This addition amounted to one acre. There are approximately 260 marked graves in it. There is nearly five hundred in all. It is fenced with a very good fence but other than that it isn't kept up very well. Some of the caskets have settled and left a deep hole. There is one grave out in the section line road. It is fenced with a wooden fence.
