To all these presents may come greetings. Know you.

That Henry F. Murray having applied to us for License to Practice law and who having examined him and finding him learned in the Laws of the Chickasaw Nation do hereby authorize and License the said Henry F. Murray Esq. to practice law in all the Courts of the Chickasaw Nation.

Given under our hands and official Signatures this 2nd day
of July 1880.
