An Interview with Mrs. I. T. Inge,
Age 89 years, White,
Atoka, Oklahoma.

Mrs. I. T. Inge has a collection of old books, now owned by her, that were used by her grandfather and also her father, Reverend R. J. Hogue who was born in 1820. Reverend Hogue was a missionary to the Choctaw Indians. These books and many others were used in his work in organizing Churches, Sunday-schools, Lodges, and Pioneer Clubs and small community schools for the Choctaws and others at Armstrong Academy, Boggy Depot and Atoka and in the surrounding territory.

Mrs. Inge has a box of school books stored in the attic of her home that were used before, during and after the Civil War by the small schools organized in this part of the Choctaw Nation, which now is Atoka and Bryan Counties. This is a partial list of her books:
