

Frank Booker, Box 237, Luther, Oklahoma. Born August 15, 1861, Bedford, Iowa. Parents, Mr. and Mrs. Jacob Jasper Booker. White.

MR. BOOKER'S STORY:

"The parents didn't come, but Frank Booker & his wife came in Jan. 1893" They came from Kansas.

"Moved by train, chartered a car to Guthrie, from there to near Fallis by wagon which is in Lincoln Co..

"We lived among the Iowa Indians near Fallis. In a month 'White Cloud' the Chief died. We went to the funeral. That was the first Iowa Indian to be buried in a casket. Many of the Indians were taking allotments near Perkins and began moving there. In four years we moved to the vicinity of Perkins and lived there eight years.

"Dan Toe hee was now their chief. He was killed by his son-in-law with a hoe. His brother Dave became chief next. We became very well acquainted with the tribe during our 8 yrs near there."
