## MR. COCK'S STORY:

My parents came to Oklahoma from California in 1883, by the Northern Route. They came by train and went into Texas first.

"I. Road [sic.] the Country from Red River to the South Canadian for 5 years up to 1888 then got married then leased from John Vian on Okla line E(a)st of Norman now

"I made the Run from Pat(t)awato(mie) Res(ervation) -on west Side on Litt(l)e River filed on S-W $\frac{1}{2}$  S. 26 9-1-W In May 1889

"I. was at every opining [sic.] of Okla Filed again at the opening of Comanch(e) and Kiowa

"Run from 2 mi[e]s East of Orlando into Perry got lot and built house Hotell [sic.]"
