MRS. FISHER'S STORY:

My parents came to Oklahoma in 1879 from Illinois and Indiana.

"With oxen and covered wagons of a train of 30 wagons in 1877

"Joe Bartles. Dewey Oria (founder of Bartlesville)

"George Roberts. Tom Muecom were big game hunters.

Pioneer towns were Chelsea. Alluwe. Pawhuska, Pellaquah Tulsa. Country Dance. Church. Bronze Riding.

Barbecues, Country picnic were the rec[re]ation.

"Stage Route. Moline Kans to Pawhuska operated By Monroe Mucgrave. at a wed[ding] the bride was traded for Ponies as many as 50. or 100 Ponies a Big Feast. their clothing was a Very gay shirt. Beaded leg[g]ing[s].

Locca[si]ns. Strowd. or Blankey at Salina Okla a mission one at Pellaquah: one out linedot.

"They drew a payment every 3 month[s] in 1879 The Osages drew \$8 Per head but was furnished food By government. Drums [drums ?]. coconut shells with shot
