MR. GRIMES STORY:

"I came to Okla. 1900 from Richmond Ind., being the only member of our family to Okla.

"The first work was with U. S. Townsite survey, our party surveying 45 gov. townsites in Ind. later with R. R. Survey party of which late G. B. Stone of Okla. City was promoting line Okla City to Wichita Falls, Tex. 'O & T' never constructed.

"Then with R. R. Survey 'Okla Central' Paris Tex to Chickasha, Okla of which Atoka - Chickasha part of line was constructed, this line promoted by Late Dorset Carter and after few years sold to Santa Fe. During Indian allotment I located and filed Indians on their Home Steads & Surpluses.

"Later Real Estate & farm loans was my occupation in Garvin & adj counties."
