MR. LOUTHAN'S STORY:

My parents came to Oklahoma in the Spring of 1890, from Kansas. They were both born in Ohio.

"We were R R people my brother- the first Rock Island Agent in the Indian Territory myself his helper - All Freight For Ft. Sill & For the Kiowa, Comanche Caddo Apaches at Ft Sill and Anadarko Agency was Freightd From Minco by Ox & Horse teams"

Since coming West we have been identified as a pioneer family, and with Indian Territory and Oklahoma.

"Transportation has always been my business and I might have something to contribute that would have some Historical value on that subject."
